## **LATVIA AND RIGA**

The area of **Latvia** is about 64 thousand square kilometers. The population of the Republic is 2,5 million people.

**Riga** - capital of Latvia is located on the Baltic Sea and a third of all Latvians live here (800 thousand inhabitants). Riga is more than 800 years old.



Riga was a major centre of the Hanseatic League, deriving its prosperity in the 13th–15th centuries from the trade with central and Eastern Europe.

Riga once was a fortified city, walled in by high ramparts with turrets and fortified gates. These walls were eventually torn down, though a few small sections remain with the so-called Swedish Gate being the oldest remaining portion and the Powder Tower.

Riga became an important economic centre in the 19th century, when the suburbs surrounding the medieval town were laid out, first with imposing wooden buildings in neoclassical style and then in *Jugendstil* (Art Nouveau). It is generally recognized that Riga has the finest collection of art nouveau buildings in Europe.

In Latvia only Latvian lats can be used. You can change your currency in the airport, hotel or in banks. 1 EUR is approximately 0.70 LVL.

### PASSPORT AND VISA

**University of Latvia** 

The University of Latvia was founded in 1919 on the basis of the former Riga Polytechnic (founded in 1862). In 1923 this school received its present name - the University of Latvia (Universitas Latviensis). The former building of Riga Polytechnic is located at 19 Raina Boulevard and serves as the symbol of the University even nowadays.

With Latvia regaining freedom the Supreme Council of the Republic of Latvia confirmed the Constitution of the University of Latvia in 1991. It stated that the Higher School is "a state establishment of academic education, science and culture which serves the needs of Latvia and people".

University of Latvia integrates diverse fields of research and studies with creative initiative to provide higher education of European standard, to cultivate the Latvian language and traditions of cultural cooperation.

### FROM AIRPORT

There is a regular **bus** service (bus No. 22 and 22a) between Riga airport and the city centre. To get on the bus at the airport look for bus stop located opposite the terminal behind the car park. Frequency 10 - 30 minutes from 5:30 a.m. to 10:40 p.m. Journey time about 30 minutes. Tickets are obtained in the bus and the cost of the ticket is 20 or 25 santims.

The most convenient way to get to the hotels from the airport is **by taxi**. Taxi stop is located in front of the Arrival hall. The fare is about 10 LVL.
